

Description of Works

Introduction to the Project

Work will commence in spring 2018 on the Construction of the new hard play area, access ramp and steps located at the front left-hand side of the school on the playing field, this work will take approximately 10 weeks. Construction of the two new accommodation blocks A and B which are designed to address the current deficiencies in the current school accommodation, with link corridors from the existing school will commence when the work to the Hard Play area has been completed. During the summer holidays 2018 work to widen the front entrance drive off the North Road will be carried out, when completed a set down area with widened carriageway and turning roundabout will improve vehicle access for all users of the School premises. Work will be completed by Spring 2019
